AT&T Cell Tower – Steve Ward / Dustin Blythe

- Proposal : 90 ft cell tower disguised as a tree near the entrance of Memorial Park on Brownell Talbot campus
- Proposal will go to City Planning Meeting Wednesday April 4th if approved will then go to City Hall
- According to AT&T they would like to go further north but there are fewer options in the residential neighborhoods
- The purpose is to gain coverage and capacity to the north and on UNO campus
- The tower will be built for multiple carriers to use to minimize the number of towers in the area
- AT&T presented to the grounds committee at Brownell a bell tower, monument and tree Brownell chose the tree option
- There is a bill being introduced to have more small towers around neighborhoods but it wouldn't make the large towers obsolete
- Terms of the lease: 5 year lease with 4 automatic 5 year renewal options
- Concerns:
 - Height : there is nothing close to 90 feet tall in the area
 - o Esthetics : will it affect the look of the neighborhood
 - o Location: on the edge of Memorial Park
